ORDER:

Organic Farming is a holistic production management system which promotes and enhances agro-ecosystem health, including biodiversity, biological cycles, and soil biological activity. It emphasises the use of management practices in preference to the use of off-farm inputs, taking into account that regional conditions require locally adapted systems. This is accomplished by using, where possible, agronomic, biological, and mechanical methods, as opposed to using synthetic materials, to fulfill any specific function within the system. The State of Andhra Pradesh would like to promote Organic Farming which is beneficial to the farmers and the environment. The matter has been deliberated on this issue and felt necessary to constitute a committee which will examine the best practices, available technologies / protocols in organic farming and prepare draft policy for organic farming for the AP State.
